On with the title - Thinking along these lines, I thought by capturing and offering a glimpse into the Blue Angels' concept of teamwork, perhaps we can gain a better understanding of teamwork as it relates to our fraternity, own lives. So far during my short tenure as a brother, I noticed something strange taking place.
